BY REGISTERING I/WE AGREE TO FOLLOW THE BELOW GUIDELINES

- Be advised that our building is not fully accessible to those with physical disabilities. Building entry and access to the sanctuary on the second and third floors and restrooms in the basement require steps. We do not have an elevator.
- Government issued photo ID will be required for entry into the synagogue.
- Do not attend if you do not feel well, have a fever, are experiencing any symptoms of Covid-19 or have tested positive, or have a cold, flu or any other communicable illness.
- Our shul is mask friendly for those who choose to wear them.
- Bring your own mask (optional), kippah and tallit if you have them.
- All attendees under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or other responsible adult.
- Large bags and parcels are not allowed in the synagogue.
- All items brought into the synagogue are subject to search.
- Outside food and beverages may not be brought into the building except for water.
- Photography and videography are not permitted.
- Hazardous materials and weapons of any kind are prohibited.
- Smoking, including electronic cigarettes and vaping devices, is not allowed in the building.
- Pets are not allowed in the building. Registered service animals are permitted.
